- This guide does not include any remedial courses that may be required at OCC and may not include prerequisite requirements.
- Olivet College requires that a minimum of a "C" (2.0) be earned in each course in order to be considered for transfer credit, non-germane and remedial courses may not qualify for transfer credit.
